

Multi-use trails

(dogs and bikes permitted)



Labrador Loop (2.0 mi.)
Wide, level, graveled trail through floodplain forest with views of Pennypack Creek, Crossroads Marsh, forest restoration and several sites of historic significance. This loop connects Montgomery County's Pennypack Trail to the Trust's Creek Trail.



Creek Trail (2.7 mi.)
Level dirt and gravel footpath; may be muddy in the winter and following rains. A highly varied forested floodplain experience that traverses the length of the Pennypack Ecological Restoration Trust. This is not a loop but connects to various County trail systems.

Hiking trails

(foot traffic only; no pets or bikes)



Chickadee Loop (0.8 mi.)
Our easiest trail loop features an incredible diversity over a short distance including beautiful meadows, a majestic old forest, and panoramic views.



Blue Stem Loop (1.6 mi.)
A short loop with lots to offer (wetlands, grasslands, mature woodlands and the Pennypack Creek). Challenging terrain and a rewarding experience.



Coyote Loop (3.1 mi.)
Become immersed in an extended tour of grasslands, woodlands, the varied expressions of the creek and its floodplain.

Help us protect the preserve during your visit today:



The Preserve is open from dawn to dusk
You just enjoyed your time in nature, let the wildlife have theirs. Please respect their needs by leaving before dark.



Stay on designated trails
Going off-trail causes erosion and damages trailside plants. Dogs and bikes are only permitted on the Laborador Loop, Creek Trail, and Montgomery County "Pennypack Trail." Swimming is not permitted.



Trash your trash
Please pick up all trash, even biodegradable materials like food scraps, which are unsightly and attract scavengers that can harm native wildlife.



Keep noise down and group sizes small.
No drones or other flying apparatuses
No motorized vehicles, speakers, drones, or loud groups. Loud noises and flying objects disrupt wildlife and the quiet experience others are here to enjoy. No organized groups without permission.

Keep dogs on-leash and clean up after them



Dogs must be leashed at all times, and on permitted trails only. Please bag pet waste and take it with you. This preserve is for wild canines, not domestic. Dog waste confuses signals for foxes, coyotes, and other wildlife that mark territories.



No tobacco
Smoke disturbs wildlife and disrupt the experience others are here to enjoy.



No foraging, antler collection, hunting or trapping
Leave nature the way you found it. Foraging and antler collection are disruptive to their habitat.



Fishing is catch-and-release only
Live bait; "Power Bait," and scented lures are not allowed to avoid setting the hook deeper hook sets which are likely to kill the fish. Fishing is only permitted in the creek, not in ponds.
